This is the first appeal that has been filed against the order of the District Judge, Gurdaspur whereby, the objection filed by the appellants-Miller under Section 34 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 for setting aside the award dated 17.08.2015 passed by the Arbitrator has been dismissed.

Learned counsel for the appellants-Miller submits that during the pendency of the proceedings before the High Court, the matter has been settled under One Time Settlement scheme that was initiated between the parties. In this regard, he places on record No Dues Certificate issued by PUNSUP, which would reflect that matter stands settled under One Time Settlement scheme with the appellants-Miller.

At this stage, Mr. Jatinder Singh, Advocate puts in appearance

on behalf of respondent No.1-PUNSUP and does not dispute the No Dues Certificate produced on record by the appellants-Miller.

In view of the above, no further orders are called for.
