Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 170, dated 22.6.2019, registered under Sections 147,149,323,324,302,307,450 IPC at P.S. City Siwani, District Bhiwani.

FIR was lodged on the statement of one Girdhari that his brother Lilu Ram, an auto rickshaw driver, had gone to tyre puncture shop of Raju at 10:00 PM on 21.6.2019. A Bolero vehicle of white colour alongwith 10-12 boys, who were armed with axe and sticks, came there. Complainant knew name of one of them, namely, Parkash. Parkash raised lalkara alongwith his fellows that they will teach a lesson to Lilu Ram and Kaptan for raising voice against him in the village. Thereafter, Parkash, who was holding axe in his hand, hit the head of Lilu Ram brother of complainant and also inflicted injuries to Kaptan. Others also joined him in hitting Lilu Ram and Kaptan with sticks. Lilu Ram died in the incident. The name of petitioner came up in the disclosure statement of Parkash that he was with him alongwith other boys when injuries were inflicted to the deceased.

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Challan has been filed against 11 accused. The petitioner has been evading arrest. Allegations are serious. There is no ground to grant anticipatory bail to petitioner. Dismissed.
