The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 212 dated 24.07.2019, under Sections 409 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Sadar Gohana, District Sonapat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR has been registered after four years of the alleged incident wherein the petitioner is an accused of having received an amount of ₹59,000/- from two persons and although he had made entry in their passbook, but the money was not deposited in the government account. He also contends that the petitioner had deposited the amount in the year 2016 itself and there is no other complaint against him.

This Court, by the order dated 09.09.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating/Arresting Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Naresh Kumar, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation and not required for custodial interrogation, the order dated 09.09.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
