Learned counsel for respondent No. 3-Insurance Company states that the matter has been compromised between the parties in terms of which respondent No. 3-Insurance Company has agreed to give ₹ 8,50,000/- in lumpsum including interest and cost, to the claimant over and above the amount of compensation awarded to him by Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Sonipat vide award dated 17.07.2015. This amount is to be paid to the claimant within 60 days from today.

Learned counsel for the appellant alongwith learned counsel for the respondent No.3-Insurance Company are agreeable to the same.

Learned counsel for the parties states that the appeal may be disposed of accordingly. The impugned award is modified and claimant is awarded an additional compensation of ₹ 8.5 lacs, in lumpsum including

interest and cost payable by respondent No. 3-Insurance Company over and above the compensation of ₹ 4,64,600/- awarded by Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Sonipat vide award dated 17.07.2015.

Respondent No.3-Insurance Company would pay this amount to the claimant through cheque in the name of claimant, within 60 days from today, failing which Insurance Company would be liable to pay interest @ 7.5% per annum on said amount thereafter.

The cheque is to be deposited by the Insurance Company in the Lok Adalat branch, within stipulated period, as agreed.

No order as to the costs.

The appeal is disposed of, accordingly.
