Through the instant petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., 1973, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 87 dated 28.06.2019 registered under Sections 22 of NDPS Act, 1985, at Police Station Koom Kalan, District Ludhiana.

On 11.09.2019, this Court passed the following order :-

“ *Notice of motion for 06.11.2019.*

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when

called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. ”.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 11.09.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Today, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Randhir Singh, stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for investigation.

Looking to the circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 11.09.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
