The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.249 dated 12.06.2019, under Sections 420,467,468,471,120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860, Section 63 of Copy Right Act, 1957 and Section 61 of Punjab Excise Act, 1914, registered at Police Station Safidon, District Jind.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR are that recovery of liquor was effected from the rented premises of co-accused Anil Kumar @ Kala and petitioner was only a worker in the factory. He is in custody for over three months since his arrest on 12.06.2019.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Parveen Kumar states that although the challan has been presented but charges are yet to be framed.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 03 months and conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
