Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.205 dated 08.08.2019 under Sections 61/78 of Punjab Excise Act, 1914, registered at Police Station Sardulgarh, District Mansa.

While granting interim bail to the petitioners, following order was passed by this Court on 09.09.2019: -

“... Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that recovery of 24 bottles has already been effected and the petitioners are not involved in any other case...”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioners have joined the investigation and are not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Maya Ram, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioners are no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 09.09.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
