This is 2nd petition for grant of anticipatory bail to petitioner Lakhvir Singh, in FIR No.31 dated 23.06.2019 under Sections 452, 323, 506, 34 IPC (Sections 307/325 IPC were added later on), registered at Police Station Tallewal, District Barnala, earlier one was dismissed as withdrawn on 21.08.2019, while granting interim bail to co-accused Sukhjiwan Singh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is no direct allegation against the petitioner and he has been falsely implicated in the FIR. It is further submitted that Section 307 IPC is not made out against the petitioner, as it was added later on.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, I find no ground to entertain the second petition for grant of anticipatory bail.

As per allegations in the FIR, petitioner Lakhvir Singh along with

co-accused Sukhjiwan Singh, with an intention to cause grievous hurt to the complainant, entered his house. The petitioner was carrying a baseball bat and his brother/co-accused Sukhjiwan Singh was having a stick. On reaching house of the complainant, they started abusing him. When the complainant tried to stop them from doing so, the petitioner gave a baseball bat blow on his head, which was prevented by the complainant by raising his hands. Co-accused Sukhjiwan Singh gave a stick blow on the right foot of complainant and he fell down. Thereafter, both the accused persons caused injuries to the complainant.

As per medical report, injury No.2, on the person of the complainant, was declared dangerous to life and this injury is specifically attributed to petitioner Lakhvir Singh.

In view of the above, I find no ground to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Petition is dismissed.
