Pleadings on record have been perused.

Both the petitioners are stated to have attained the age of majority. Petitioner No.1 is stated to be 26 years old and petitioner No.2 is 25 years old. It is stated to be a live-in relationship.

It is pleaded that petitioner No.2 was married to respondent No.4 but on account of harassment having been meted out in the matrimonial home, she has left and is now residing with respondent No.1.

Counsel submits that under such circumstances, the petitioners fear for their life at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7.

Without commenting upon the relationship between the parties, liberty is granted to the petitioners to approach respondent No.3 confined to the aspect of danger to their life.

In the eventuality of any such application being preferred, respondent No.3 would examine the same and take steps as he may deem fit.
