Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 63 dated 08.05.2018, registered under Sections 302, 307, 323, 148, 149, 435, 506, 447, 511 of the IPC and Sections 25, 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Guruhar Sahai, District Ferozepur.

On 09.09.2019, the following order was passed:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is an old man aged about 73 years and relies upon the order dated 28.08.2019 passed in CRM-M-35152-2019, vide co-accused Mangal Singh and Inderjit Singh have already been granted the concession of interim bail.

Notice of motion for 13.09.2019.

In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court within a period of 03 days from today and the trial Court will release him on interim bail

subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 09.09.2019, has already appeared before the trial Court and has been released on interim bail. A copy of the order, passed by the trial in this regard, is also placed on record.

Learned counsel for the State, assisted by learned counsel for the complainant, has not disputed the factual position.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and order dated 09.09.2019 is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
