Counsel for the appellants would state that in case income of the deceased is assessed on the basis of minimum wage available at the relevant time and deduction for personal expenses to the extent of 50% as the deceased was unmarried but addition for future prospects is allowed, the net result would be reduction of compensation and as such the appeal may be dismissed as withdrawn.
