Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in FIR No.66 dated 29.05.2019 registered under Sections 323, 324, 307, 427, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Nurpur Bedi, District Roopnagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that all the injuries to the injured allegedly inflicted by the petitioner and co-accused have been declared simple in nature.

Petitioner is already in custody since 23.06.2019. He is not involved in any other case. Regular bail application of co-accused Pawan Kumar has been allowed vide order dated 20.09.2019 passed in CRM-M-39081-2019.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in

view the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 23.06.2019 and the trial of the case is likely to take a long time, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
