On 11.9.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.88 dated 29.05.2019 registered under Sections 324, 323, 506, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code and under Section 326 IPC (added later on) at Police Station Guruharsahai, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that initially when the FIR was registered, the offences under which the case was registered were bailable and, therefore, petitioner joined investigation and Investigating Officer admitted him to bail. However, later on, offence under Section 326 IPC has been added and now the petitioner is sought to be arrested. He further submits that there is a cross-version and the petitioner had also suffered injuries.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab and seeks time to get instructions.

Adjourned to 06.11.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Raj Singh has submitted that petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, order dated 11.9.2019 is hereby made absolute.

Petition stands allowed.
