On 11.09.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.163 dated 25.08.2019 registered under Sections 379/420 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Sadar Ambala, District Ambala.

Allegations against the petitioner are that he had stolen a blank signed cheque worth ₹50,000/- delivered to M/s Jai Bharat Filling Station and encashed the same.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the aforesaid cheque had been handed over to the petitioner by the Manager towards consideration for sale of a buffalo.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Manish Bansal, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of State of Haryana and

seeks time to get instructions.

Adjourned to 06.11.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Ajit Pal, has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, order dated 11.09.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
