Petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.109 dated 24.04.2019 registered under Sections 406, 420 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Farakpur, District Yamunanagar.

As per case of the prosecution, petitioner alongwith other co-accused including her husband had defrauded first informant of ₹18,16,973/-.

On 09.09.2019, learned counsel for the petitioner had contended that petitioner is neither Director nor officer of the Maha Music and Film Production House Private Limited.

Learned counsel for the first informant/complainant has produced copy of brochures which show that the petitioner is depicted as

Producer of various songs and documentaries.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this Court does not find it appropriate to grant concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner particularly when majority of amount has been transferred by the first informant during bank transactions.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
