HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

This is a petition filed for grant of bail in case FIR No. 69
dated 05.05.2019 registered under Section 21 of the N.D.P.S. Act, 1985
at Police Station Mehta, Amritsar Rural, District Amritsar.

As per the allegations made in the FIR, secret information
was received that the petitioner Harnam Singh along with Angrej Singh
were coming in a car i20 black colour number PB-02-BK-0606 from
Rayya to Batala. The car was intercepted. On search, 255 grams of
Heroin was recovered from the possession of petitioner, who was
driving the car and Rs. 3,20,000/- were recovered from Angrej Singh

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Parshotam Sharma states that investigation in the case is complete, challan has been filed and charges have been framed against the petitioner.

The petitioner is in custody from 05.05.2019 and there is no other case in the N.D.P.S. registered against him. The trial of the case may take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping him in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of present case; without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

However, if petitioner indulges in any activity of similar nature, while on bail, prosecution agency will be at liberty to seek cancellation of order granting bail to petitioner.
