AVNEESH JHINGAN, J. (Oral)

Learned counsel for respondent No. 3-Insurance Company contends that the matter has been compromised and it has been settled that the insurer would be paying ₹ 75,000/- to the appellant over and above the amount already awarded by Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Gurgaon.

Learned counsel for the appellant states that the appeal should be disposed of as per settlement and the insurer be directed to pay the settled amount of ₹ 75,000/- in a time bound manner.

In view of the statements made by learned counsel for the parties, the appeal is disposed of. The insurer is directed to pay the amount of ₹ 75,000/- as agreed within six weeks from today.

Learned counsel for the insurer undertakes that he shall deposit the said amount of ₹ 75,000/- by way of cheque with the Lok Adalat within six weeks from today. The appellant shall move an application for disbursement of the said amount. In case of failure of respondent No. 3 to deposit the agreed amount within the stipulated time, the appellant shall be entitled to interest @ 9% per annum from the date of filing the claim petition till the realization of the amount.
