ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 16, dated 19.01.2018, under Sections 307, 326, 323 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' - for short), registered at Police Station City Batala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he had given a 'datar' blow on the head of the complainant. The complainant has fully recovered from the injury. The petitioner is in custody for over 01 year and not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel states that the investigation has been completed and the challan has been presented.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is in custody for over a year, he is not involved in any other case and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
