On 9.9.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail
in FIR No.115 dated 31.08.2019 registered under
Section 306 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station
Bareta, District Mansa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends
that one Amrik Singh had agreed to purchase the house
in question and paid substantial amount and the
petitioner was making efforts to resolve the dispute
which had arisen between the vendor and the vendee.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Bhupender
Beniwal, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the
State and seeks time to get instructions.

Let a copy of the petition be handed over to

learned counsel for the State during course of the day.

Adjourned to 29.10.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Mewa Singh has submitted that petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, order dated 9.9.2019 is hereby made absolute.

Petition stands allowed.
