Petitioner herein seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to consider and promote the petitioner as Head teacher w.e.f. Juniors were promoted as Head Teacher with all consequential benefits including arrears of pay etc. and further direction to respondents to benefit of the letter to the males too.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that once the persons who were junior to the petitioner have been granted promotion, the petitioner is also entitled for promotion from the said date. In the premise, petitioner had given a representation dated 30.07.2015 (Annexure P-4), the same has not been adverted by the respondents till date.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On advance service of the petition, Ms. Anu Chatrath, Sr.

Advocate with Ms. Ambika Bedi, AAG., Punjab appears and accepts notice

on behalf of the State.

5. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by the respondents as no further proceedings and /or pleadings are required.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the representation dated 30.07.2015 (Annexure P-4) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in the present writ petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

7. Let the needful be done within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
