Petitioner seeks a mandamus for directing the official respondents to protect his life and liberty by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 7.

Counsel for the petitioner has been heard at length.

In the considered view of this Court no intervention in the matter is required.

Apparently, petitioner had contested election and was elected as Sarpanch of Village and defeating his rival i.e. respondent No.8. On account of an occurrence which took place on 02.03.2019 an FIR as also a cross-case stand registered inter-se the parties. On a specific query having been put, counsel is not in a position to address this Court as regards current status of investigation.

The instant writ petition can only be seen as a fall out of inter-se political rivalry between the parties.

Prayer raised in the petition as such cannot be accepted.

Petition dismissed.
