Petitioner claims that she was engaged as Lecturer, Economics with the Punjab School of Economics, G.N.D.U., Amritsar on a part time basis in the year 2018. Petitioner submitted her joining report on 6.9.2018 and has been delivering lectures to the classes assigned to her.

Counsel would refer to order dated 5.9.2018 issued by respondent no.2 (Annexure P-2) as per which, Rs.600/- remuneration is to be paid per lecture per hour subject to maximum of Rs.30,000/- per month.

The short grievance raised in the petition is that inspite of bills having been submitted for release of a total payment of Rs.57,000/- in lieu of lectures delivered and such bills having been countersigned by the Head of Department concerned, yet, the payment has not been released.

In the light of the short grievance noticed herein above and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the instant petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the same with a direction to the Registrar of the respondent university to examine the claim of the petitioner against the backdrop of a legal notice dated 14.5.2019 (Annexure P-7) and to take a final decision thereupon expeditiously and in any case within a period of three months from today.

Needless to observe that if any amount is found due, the same would be released without any further delay.

It is, however, clarified that this Court has not examined the claim of the petitioner on merits.

Disposed of.
