Petitioner, which is a proprietorship firm has filed the instant petition for directing the respondent authorities to release the sanctioned capital subsidy/investment incentive of Rs.2,17,000/- as per sanction letter dated 5.2.1997 (Annexure P-1).

It is the case of the petitioner that inspite of repeated reminders/representations the capital subsidy amount as noticed herein above has not been released.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. A.P.S. Gill learned A.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents and waives service. A complete copy of the writ paper book has already been furnished to learned State counsel.

Statement of learned State counsel is recorded to the effect that the matter would be examined and either the capital subsidy would be released to the petitioner as per seniority or if the petitioner is found not entitled to the same, a speaking order in such regard would be passed and conveyed to it.

In view of the statement recorded of learned State counsel, no further directions are required to be passed.

Petition is disposed of.
