Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.69 dated 28.07.2019 under Sections 452, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Sanour, District Patiala.

As per allegations in the FIR, registered at the instance of Jagtar Singh, the petitioner was armed with a danda, co-accused Jashanpreet Singh and Jagtar Singh were armed with baseball and danda respectively, however, Bhajan Singh was armed with a wooden stick. All the accused persons caused injuries to wife of the complainant, namely Soni Devi. The petitioner is attributed danda blow on the forehead of injured Soni Devi and other accused have also caused injuries to wife of the complainant and she has suffered five injuries.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that it is a case of version and cross-version and one co-accused Harbhajan Singh has already been granted the concession of anticipatory bail by this Court.

A perusal of the order dated 22.08.2019 passed in CRM-M-34068-2019, filed by Harbhajan Singh, shows that he was not attributed the grievous injury, as attributed to the petitioner, which is on forehead of the injured.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, considering the serious allegations levelled against the petitioner, I find no ground to grant her anticipatory bail.

Dismissed.
