The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 98 dated 04.07.2019, registered under Section 420 IPC at Police Station City Batala, District Batala.

The operative part of the order dated 11.09.2019, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was not named in the FIR and the person named in the FIR, i.e. Gurpreet Singh, already stands arrested, however, no recovery of fake currency has been effected from him.

Notice of motion for 30.09.2019.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 11.09.2019, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Baghel Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner

has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 11.09.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
