Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that vide order dated 28.02.2019 (Annexure P-1), this Court had remanded the matter back to the Collector for re-assessment of the compensation and it was observed in para 8 of the order that village Sil Kapra now falls in Tehsil Kharar and thus, is within the territorial jurisdiction of District Judge, SAS Nagar, (Mohali). An opportunity was granted to the present petitioners to record correct factors to substantiate their case by leading additional aspect on the issue of severance.

The grievance of the petitioners is that after 28.02.2019 some documents have been led by the petitioners. However vide order dated 22.07.2019 (Annexure P-3) the evidence of the petitioners was closed and inadvertently two maps could not be placed by the petitioners, one of the maps has been placed on record as Annexure P-5.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Ashok Kumar Singla, Senior Deputy Advocate General,

Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Since the matter had been remanded back giving the petitioners opportunity to lead evidence, order dated 22.07.2019 (Annexure P-3) is set aside. Petition is allowed and one effective opportunity is being granted to the petitioners to lead their additional evidence in the form of two maps and thereafter relevant evidence can be led by the State as well.
