INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.222 dated 23.11.2018, registered at Police Station Guru Harsahai, District Ferozepur, under Sections 420, 406 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the FIR, the petitioner was posted as Inspector Grade-II, PUNSUP, Ferozepur, and deputed in Mandi Jiwan Arai and Panje Ke Uttar for the purchase of paddy for the year 2018-19. However, co-accused, commission agents, with the connivance of the petitioner has shown the purchase of 81863 bags of paddy, but on physical

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verification, only 26020 bags of paddy were found stored in the Mill.

Serious allegations have been levelled against the present petitioner.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and in view of the fact that the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation, I do not find it a fit case where he is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
