Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in FIR No.18, dated 13.03.2019 registered under Section 22/61 of the NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Badali Ala Singh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

The case of the prosecution is that he was found in possession of the 1100 narcotic tablets which falls within the limit of commercial quantity.

Learned Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Major Singh, Investigating Officer, has also submitted that there is another case registered against the petitioner vide FIR No.194 of 2018, under Section 21 NDPS Act, Police Station Khanna.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, no ground to grant the concession of regular bail is made out.

Dismissed.
