Petitioner-Baljinder Singh has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.63 dated 03.06.2019 under Section 22-C of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Baragudha, District Sirsa, Haryana.

The prosecution case is that on 03.06.2019, during patrolling by police party, 39,400 intoxicating tablets (containing tramadol hydrochloride) were recovered from the petitioner's possession.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is pointed out that the investigation is complete and charges are yet to be framed, therefore, further custody of the petitioner is not justified. It is prayed that the petitioner be released on regular bail.

On the other hand, learned State counsel on instructions from HC Surjeet has opposed the bail application on the ground that quantity recovered from the petitioner falls within the ambit of commercial quantity, therefore, the petitioner does not deserve the concession of regular bail.

Considering the nature of contraband recovered from the petitioner, no case is made out for grant of regular bail to the petitioner, at this stage.

Consequently, petition is dismissed.
