Petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.16 dated 16.01.2019, under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC, 1860 (Act No.45 of Year 1860) and Section 24 of Immigration Act, 1983 and Section 13 of Punjab Prevention of Human Smuggling Act, 2012 registered at Police Station Salem Tabri, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations are primarily against the co-accused, namely, Bhagwan Singh, who is alleged to have taken money from the complainant for sending them abroad. The petitioner has been arrayed as an accused as she is the mother-in-law of the co-accused Bhagwan Singh and there is no allegation that any money was paid to the petitioner. She is not involved in any other case.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 11.09.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Arresting/Investigating officer and join the investigation and in the event of her doing so, she was ordered to be released on interim bail subject to her

furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating officer.

Learned State counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit of Anil Kumar Kohli, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police(North), Ludhiana, today in Court. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof, has been handed over to the learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Baljit Singh, states that although the petitioner has joined the investigation but recovery of money is yet to be effected.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 11.09.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. She shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
