In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for regular bail under the provision of Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.106 dated 31.03.2019, under Section 20 of The Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short 'NDPS Act') registered at Police Station Dadri Sadar, District Charkhi Dadri (Annexure P-1).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner was arrested on 31.03.2019 and from the last 5½ months, he is in custody. Challan has been presented but only one witness has been examined. No purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bar as trial of the case would take some time.

3. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner.

4. In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner has already undergone custody period of 5½ months and disposal of the trial will take sufficient time, I deem it appropriate to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

5. Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the

case, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner-Dharambir is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate concerned.

6. However, the petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall also not influence the witnesses or other wise interfere with the fair trial.

7. Petition stands allowed.
