[1] At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has submitted representation (Annexure P-10) dated 31.08.2019 but that no decision has been taken on the same and that the petitioner would be satisfied, if at this stage, the writ petition is disposed of by directing the respondents to consider and decide the said representation in accordance with rules and regulations applicable in a time bound manner, in view of the fact that the last date for taking admissions to the LLB (IInd Year) is 30.09.2019.

[2] In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the writ petition is ***disposed of*** at this stage, by directing respondent No.1 to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-10) dated 31.08.2019 as per rules and regulations applicable within 10 days from date of receipt of certified copy of the order. Copy of decision taken on

the representation be furnished to the petitioner to enable him to avail of

remedy if any, in accordance with law if the circumstances of the case so warrant.
