Counsel submits that in pursuance to an alleged fraud committed upon the petitioner pertaining to a sale deed dated 24.12.2018, a complaint had been made to the Deputy Commissioner, Amritsar. Inquiry having been marked into the matter, a report was furnished by the Sub Registrar-I in which prima facie a view was taken that a fraud has actually been committed with the complainant (petitioner herein).

The short grievance raised in the petition is that even though such report has been furnished to the concerned authorities including the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar as also SDM, Amritsar-I, no further action has yet been taken.

Having heard counsel for the petitioner at length, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant writ petition without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the matter against the backdrop of the report dated 22.04.2019 at Annexure P-2 and to thereafter take steps as deemed fit

and warranted in accordance with law.
