The present appeal is preferred by the appellant-husband against the judgement and decree dated 14.05.2015 by which petition filed by the respondent-wife under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 for seeking dissolution of the marriage by a decree of divorce was allowed.

Learned counsel for the appellant-husband has submitted that the present appeal has become infructuous because the parties have entered into a compromise. Therefore, he has prayed for its withdrawal.

In view thereof, the present appeal is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to appellant-husband to file an application for its revival in case respondent-wife fails to comply with the terms and conditions of the agreement/compromise entered into between them.
