CM-14606-CII-2019:

This is an application for preponment of the date of hearing of the appeal. For the reasons stated in the application, same is allowed. Date in the main case is preponed for today.

CM-14607-CII-2019:

This is an application for waiving off with the statutory period of six months to enable the parties to depose at the second motion. It has been stated therein that there are no chances of reconciliation between the parties, thus, no useful purpose will be served by delaying the proceedings any further. This court realize that parties have already made their statements at first motion. Today they are present in the court and ready to make the statements on second motion.

In view of above, application is allowed and the statutory period of six months is hereby waived off.

FAO-M-285-2015:

Parties got married on 22.12.2006. Differences developed between them soon after marriage. Husband Gurpreet Singh Dhanoa filed a petition before the Additional District Judge, Ludhiana under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act. Same was, however, dismissed. The judgment was impugned before this court in the instant appeal. During the pendency of the appeal, application was moved for treating the appeal as petition under Section 13-B of the Act, in view of settlement arrived at between the parties. Same was reduced into writing and is on record.

Learned counsel state that parties have been living separately for last several years. After the appeal was converted into proceedings under Section 13-B of the Act, parties made their statements at the first motion on 22.5.2019. Today they have deposed and tendered their affidavits Ex.P-1 & P-2 which are treated as their statements at the second motion.

In view of above, the petition for divorce by mutual consent is hereby allowed and marriage between the parties stands dissolved by a decree of divorce. Decree-sheet be drawn accordingly.
