Grievance of the petitioner is qua non-consideration of his candidature for appointment to the post of Head Teacher/Central Head Teacher despite his eligibility and being at Sr. No.58 of the merit list meant for the post of Central Head Teacher and Sr. No.257 qua the post of Head Teacher.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that persons lower in merit than the petitioner in both the categories i.e. Central Head Teacher and Head Teacher have been appointed but petitioner has been ignored ostensibly on the ground that the Degree of B.Ed. through distance education awarded to him from Jamia Millia Islamia University, which is situated outside the State of Punjab.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner's case is squarely covered by judgment dated

02.08.2019 in CWP No.29977 of 2018 rendered by this Court contained at Annexure P-14. In the premise, petitioner also submitted a representation dated 05.09.2019 (Annexure P-7) but to no avail. Hence, the writ petition.

4. Notice of motion.

5. On advance service of the petition, Ms. Samina Dhir, DAG, Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of the State.

6. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

7. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that judgment dated 02.08.2019 contained at Annexure P-14 in turn relies upon ratio rendered by a Coordinate Bench of this Court in CWP No.11049 of 2017. The earlier judgment authored by my learned brother, Jaswant Singh, J. has since attained finality, and therefore, there is no justification as to why the benefit of same be not accorded to the petitioner, contends the learned counsel.

8. In the aforesaid premise, writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the representation dated 05.09.2019 (Annexure P-7) which is stated to be pending and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in the present writ petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

9. Let the needful be done within a period of 60 days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

10. It would be appreciated that if the respondents go

through the judgment dated 02.08.2019 (Annexure P-14) read with earlier judgment dated 06.06.2019 passed in CWP No.11049 of 2017 which has concededly attained finality as not only no further intra Court appeal was preferred but the same has been implemented qua other similarly situated persons.

11. Respondents are directed to keep one post vacant in the category of Central Head Teacher as well as in the category of Head Teacher till the speaking orders, as aforesaid, are passed.

12. Disposed of in above terms.
