The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR  
No. 165 dated 30.05.2018, registered under Sections 323, 328, 34 IPC  
at Police Station Mahesh Nagar, Ambala Cantt.

The operative part of the order dated 12.09.2019, vide  
which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is  
reproduced as under:-

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 12.09.2019, the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and he has been released on interim bail.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 12.09.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
