Petitioner-husband has filed the present revision petition against the order dated 21.08.2019 passed by the learned Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Ludhiana, whereby the petitioner has been directed to pay a sum of Rs.50,000/- towards the outstanding maintenance accrued to the respondent-wife.

At this stage, counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has just joined as a Clerk with a lawyer and is not able pay the whole amount in one go. Though the petitioner intends to pay the said amount, but he is not financially well-off. He further states that the petitioner is ready to pay the said amount of Rs.50,000/- in some reasonable installments.

Having heard counsel for the petitioner, the order dated 21.08.2019 is modified to the extent that the petitioner shall move an appropriate application before the learned Additional Principal Judge,

Family Court, Ludhiana, where the maintenance petition is pending, seeking such prayer, as made hereinabove.

Disposed of.

In case, the petitioner moves such like application within 10 days from today, the learned Family Court shall fix some reasonable installment so that the petitioner can pay the outstanding maintenance.

This order is being passed without issuing notice to the respondent-wife, as it will not only cause further delay in payment of maintenance, rather the wife would be unnecessarily burdened on account of litigation expenses for causing appearance before this Court.
