1. Prayer in this petition is for extension of parole granted to the petitioner by the District Magistrate, Sirsa vide its order dated 27.08.2019 (P-2). The petitioner was granted emergency parole for a period of two weeks from 27.08.2019 to 10.09.2019 due to demise of his brother.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been taking care of the family of his late brother. He further submits that the condition of his sister-in-law (widow of his brother) is very serious and prays that period of emergency parole of the petitioner be extended.

3. The petitioner has come up at the eleventh hour asking for extension of parole which is expiring today. Moreover, the petitioner was granted emergency parole on the ground of demise of his brother and purpose of parole is over. There is no medical certificate regarding illness of

sister-in-law of the petitioner.

4. In view of the above, prayer for extension of parole is declined. The petition is dismissed directing the petitioner to surrender before the jail authorities. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to make an application for parole on the new ground of illness of his sister-in-law to the authorities.
