Petitioner prays for regular bail in FIR No.0085 dated 18.05.2018 registered under Section 22 of NDPS Act, 1985 (Act No. 61) at Police Station Lambi, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, Punjab.

As per the case of the prosecution, 11,800 intoxicant tablets/capsules were recovered from the car in which petitioner was also travelling but had fled away.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sukhjeet Singh, Investigating Officer submits that petitioner is named in the FIR and is a habitual offender as there are as many as five more criminal cases against the petitioner in State of Haryana.

Hence, no ground to release the petitioner on regular bail is made out.

Dismissed.
