This application is filed for preponement of hearing of the main case and waiving of the period stipulated under Section 13-B (2) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short 'the Act').

Application is allowed. Hearing of the case is postponed for today and the period of six months is hereby waived of.

MAIN CASE

Both the parties are present in person. We have again asked them as to whether they are seeking divorce by mutual consent voluntarily or not. Both the parties have replied in affirmative. Statements of both the parties are recorded separately and are taken on record.

In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances much less, the fact that both the parties have recorded their statements at the first and second motion stage after the respondent wife has accepted ₹ 30 lakh towards full and final payment of all disputes between the parties, accordingly, the petition filed under Section 13-B of the Act is hereby allowed and the marriage of the parties, which was solemnized on 29.11.2010, is hereby dissolved by way of decree of divorce by mutual consent. Decree sheet be prepared separately.

Petition stands disposed of.
