The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 123 dated 14.08.2019, registered under Section 379 IPC at Police Station Sirhali, District Tarn Taran.

The operative part of the order dated 11.09.2019, vide which the petitioners have been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that as per the allegations in the FIR, the discs used for the agricultural purposes, have been stolen by the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that there is a delay of more than two months in registration of the FIR.

Notice of motion for 30.09.2019.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners, in pursuance to the order dated 11.09.2019, have already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and have joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI

Harwinder Pal, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners, vide order dated 11.09.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
