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As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellants as well as counsel for the Insurance Company, separately recorded, a sum of Rs.3,30,000/- (Rupees Three Lac Thirty Thousand Only) over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal, is awarded to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim. As per statement of learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount be paid to appellant No.1-Karamjit Kaur Wd/o Sukhwinder Singh for herself and on behalf of her children as Smt.Swaranjit Kaur, Proforma respondent No.4-mother of the deceased has since expired.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit cheque in the sum of Rs.3,30,000/- (Rupees Three Lac Thirty Thousand Only) favouring appellant No.1-Karamjit Kaur Wd/o Sukhwinder Singh with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 04.07.2019. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
