ARUN MONGA, J. (ORAL)

Short controversy herein is that while on one hand, in view of administrative exigencies/public interest, the petitioner was sent on deputation, on the other hand when she came back after deputation, she was conveyed vide impugned order dated 02.04.2018 (Annexure P-11) that the post on which she had been recruited, lien was abolished upon her deputation.

Prima facie, I am of the view that once the petitioner was selected and appointed as Punjabi Language Teacher, the said post cannot be abolished on the ground that she was sent on deputation to another department. Be that as it may, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to pass appropriate orders +to allow the petitioner to join as Punjabi Language Teacher, wherever the said post is lying vacant in the State of Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that currently one

post of Punjabi Language Teacher is vacant at Patiala.

It would be appreciated if while passing the orders, respondents may take into consideration the vacant post available at Patiala for accommodating the petitioner.

Needful be done within a period of two months. Needless to say that the petitioner shall be entitled for salary for the period she was not allowed to join as there is no fault of her.
