The petitioner has come up in revision against the order dated 26.08.2019 whereby the Railway Claims Tribunal, Chandigarh Bench, Chandigarh while awarding the compensation of Rs.4,50,000/- imposed a condition that the claimant will be entitled to withdraw 10% with interest from compensation and the rest of the amount will be invested in the bank deposit as per the details given in para (ii) of the award.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has relied upon order passed by this Court in *CR No. 3111 of 2019 titled Kalita Devi V/s. Parveen and others* whereby no restriction can be imposed on the rights of an adult to claim the compensation amount deposited in his name.

This petition is allowed as the claimant/victim in the present case is about 26 years old . Hence, order dated 26.08.2019 is set aside and the total compensation is directed to be released to the petitioner within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and the report be sent to the High Court after its compliance.
