Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sahab Singh, submits that no reply has been received from the embassy of Italy or from the Ministry of Home Affairs, despite various queries made to them.

Be that as it may, learned counsel for the petitioner is also unable to answer as to why the nephews of the complainant were sent to Armenia instead of Italy, as had been allegedly promised.

The explanation that he has tried to give, is that there is a flight going from Armenia to Italy.

Very obviously, if international flights are going from different cities in the world, some flights would take off from almost every country to the capital city of another country, or at least to a country close thereto.

With there being direct flights to Italy and its neighbouring countries from New Delhi itself, as to why those persons had to be sent to

Armenia, is an explanation which is not forthcoming.

Learned State counsel further submits that though the petitioner has joined investigation, he is not cooperating in any manner.

Consequently, without making any further comment on the actual merits of the case, the petition is dismissed.
