Petitioner is seeking indulgence of this Court for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to consider the claim of petitioner for regularization in the light of policy decision dated 27.07.2011 (Annexure P-3) and grant all consequential benefits.

Learned counsel for petitioner submits that he will be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent Nos.2 & 3, to consider the legal notice dated 18.02.2019 (Annexure P-5) in view of judgments dated 22.07.2016 and 17.07.2018 (Annexures P-6 and P-7), within a stipulated period.

Without going into the merits and demerits of the claim of the petitioner, I deem it appropriate to direct respondent Nos.2 and 3, to consider the legal notice dated 18.02.2019 (Annexure P-5) in view of judgments dated 22.07.2016 and 17.07.2018 (Annexures P-6 and P-7), within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of

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this order and shall pass a speaking order thereon after affording opportunity of hearing to petitioner and taking into consideration judicial precedents as well, failing which, there shall be costs of ₹25,000/- to be paid to petitioner.

This condition of imposing costs is only to prevent petitioner to run from pillar to post and avail remedy of contempt in case of non-compliance of directions issued by this Court.

The writ petition stands disposed of with the above direction.
