On 13.09.2019, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“ Petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No. 041 dated 13.09.2018 registered under Sections 323/324/452/148/149/506 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Kabirpur (Ahalikalan), District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and two petitions relating to co-accused of the petitioner have already been allowed by granting them protection of pre-arrest bail. He refers to orders dated 08.05.2019 passed in CRM-M-16161-2019 and dated 20.08.2019 passed in CRM-M-24563-2019.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab and seeks time to get instructions.

List on 22.10.2019.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the State, on instruction from ASI Harpal Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

Hence, the order dated 13.09.2019 is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
