In the present writ petition, the claim of the petitioner is that the petitioner is entitled for the benefits under the Old Pension Scheme in respect of the service rendered by late husband of the petitioner, namely, Chaman Lal, who was working as Multipurpose Health Worker (MPHW) with the respondents . As per the pleaded facts, the late husband of the petitioner was appointed initially on contract basis as MPHW on 28.05.2007 and his services were regularized on the said post on 30.06.2011 and thereafter, he worked till 31.05.2018 when unfortunately he died.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner has not been extended any benefit of family pension on the ground that as the services of late Chaman Lal (husband of the petitioner) were regularized on 30.06.2011

Counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief which has been sought in the present writ petition, petitioner has submitted to the respondents a representation dated 22.01.2019 (Annexure P-6), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this

representation.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim as being made by the petitioner, the respondents are directed to decide the representation dated 22.01.2019 (Annexure P-6) by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
