Appellants-claimants, seek enhancement of compensation awarded by the learned Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Jhajjar (for short 'tribunal'), vide impugned award dated 06.11.2015, on account of death of Suman Devi.

Appellants filed a claim petition under Section 163-A of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (for short 'M.V.Act'), seeking compensation on account of death of Suman Devi, in a motor vehicle accident which took place on 07.07.2013, due to the use of a motorcycle bearing registration no. HR-19-F-5297.

Learned tribunal accepted the claim set up by the appellants to the effect that the deceased-Suman Devi, was in receipt of income of ₹3200/- per month and awarded a sum of ₹4,90,200/-, which is detailed as under:-

1.	Total income of deceased	₹3200/- p.m.
2.	Deduction	1/ 3 rd
3.	Multiplier	17
4.	Loss of dependency	₹4,35,200/-
5.	Compensation towards treatment of deceased	₹48,000/-
6.	Compensation towards transportation, funeral expenses and last rites ceremonies	₹2000/-
7.	Loss of consortium	₹5,000/-
	Total	₹4,90,200/-

Learned counsel for the appellant is unable to deny that the compensation has been awarded strictly in terms of the schedule as is required in a claim petition under Section 163-A of the M.V. Act. He is unable to point out any ground whatsoever for enhancement of compensation awarded by the learned tribunal.

Learned counsel for the appellants is unable to point out any illegality or infirmity in the impugned award dated 06.11.2015, passed by the learned tribunal, Jhajjar, which calls for interference by this Court.

No other argument has been raised.

Appeal is accordingly dismissed with no order as to costs.
